Presentation of the organisation

Baranya County

The Local Government decision-making is the Assembly made up of forty elected representative and nine Permanent Committees.

The main tasks of the Local Government are :

- Funding local public educational institutions of the county
- Maintaining the institutions belonging to the territorial social and healthcare system and funding their activities
- Protecting children and young people
- Developing rural areas and protecting environment

Baranya County is one of the most Southern counties of Hungary.
The county territory is 4,430 km² and it has 396.000 inhabitants. Due to its geographical location, Baranya County is one of the Southern Hungariun interface region with Croatia and the Balkans, with which it has good political and economical relations.

Baranya County Development and Project Department

The Local Government Development and Project Department prepares and manages many various projects mostly on the field of culture, tourism, sports and healthcare, employment and social development, for example the "Regional Knowledge Centre", the "Museum-development" project and the "Aqua Park" project in Orfű village.

The Local Government main activities fall within the scope of tourism development, marketing and coordination of local tourism

The main development orientations in the Region are :

- Health industry (the Science building, the Health Industry and Innovation Centre and the Rehabilitation Centre)
- Cultural industry (Conference Centre, Creative Incubator Institute, Cultural Industry Cluster)

The capital of Baranya County, the city of Pecs, will be the "European Capital of Culture" in 2010.
