The Conference is focused on these questions and intends to give voice to some consolidated experiences of experimentation, applying *governance* strategies, exalted by territorial intelligence, that is by an intelligence which describes and defines territorial identity.

1. SCHEDULE OF THE CALL FOR PAPERS

Communications must be presented in a presentation.

Communications propositions should be sent at the following address:

Communication proposals should be sent in the form of a 200-word summary in Italian (that can be accompanied by a summary in English and/or French), indicating at the beginning:

- The title
- The author and his/her professional contact
- The theme treated.

The Scientific Committee will either accept the submissions as they are or ask for improvements or suggest a different form.

The Scientific Committee will be in charge of dividing the presentations in workshops. According to the workshops, presentations will be either orally presented by the author or synthetically presented by the workshop moderator.

All accepted communications will be digitally published when the conference reception will take place.

Consequently, the authors will have to provide, in addition to the summary transmitted at the proposition time the text in less than 7 pages and the slides.

They will be published in the Conference acts. It will be possible to complete the texts provided before the conference after the debates. A editorial committee will select the best communications.

Communications will be authorised in the author's language if the presentation is also written in English and in the author's language.

All communications must be provided in addition in another language so as to favour a better communication.

We recommend to draft the PowerPoint presentations in two languages, Italian and English or French.

The conference organization will not provide any translation.
