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INTRODUCTION

This report presents of the exchanges between the WP6C and WP4I coordination groups that respectively belong to the work packages 6 “Tools for actors” and 4 “Fundamental methods”.

The WP6C coordination group aims at giving a European dimension to the contents of the territorial intelligence tools from local experiences of the CAENTI actors that use the CATALYSE method. It belongs to the work package WP6 which objective is to design and diffuse tools of territorial intelligence for the sustainable development actors.

The CATALYSE method confronts three kinds of information:

- The persons' needs, by the means of a multi-sector diagnosis and evaluation guide;
- The available services that are able to meet these needs, by the means of a repertory
- Territorial indicators that inform on the territorial and community context of the sustainable development actions.

In the framework of the participative and partnership CATALYSE method, the information of the guide and of the services repertory are drafted by the actor according to their objectives, their practices, their representations and their context. The first tasks of the WP6C is to make a synthesis of these information, by keeping those that are frequently used, independently of the place, and those which interest is validated by all the coordination group. Then, the WP6C formulates the guide and repertory questions by inspiring itself from the European standards when there are some.

This report concerns the confrontation between the guide information and the territorial indicators. The first ones are gathered from the persons, the others are constituted by the specialized organizations at the territory scale. This confrontation is generally a delicate issue as the actors do not know very well the contextual indicators, their meaning, their constitution mode and their condition uses. They also face the disparity of the territorial cuttings according to the activity sectors.

At the contents specification level, it is useful to compare the guide questions with the territorial indicators so as to formulate the guide questions and their modalities by using the indicators formulation as an inspiration source, in order to compare the two kinds of formulation. It is also indispensable to make sure the treatment protocols on the one hand of the guide information and on the other hand of the territorial indicators also compatible.

The WP6C group was animated by the universities of Franche-Comté and of Huelva. It made a synthesis of the CATALYSE diagnosis and evaluation guide at the European level from local guides that were drafted by the CAENTI territorial actors. It harmonised the guide questions in accordance with European standards insofar as it was possible. The reports “European contents specification for a CATALYSE guide for diagnosis and evaluation” (deliverable n° 51) and “Guidance notes for the use of CATALYSE information and tools” (deliverable n° 56), as well as the papers “Specifications of the contents of the European guide of diagnosis and evaluation” [SANCHEZ, GIRARDOT, 2006] and “Activities and prospects of research activities concerning tools of territorial intelligence for sustainable development actors” [GIRARDOT, 2006], give the useful information about the CATALYSE method, about the diagnosis and evaluation guide, and about the elaboration of the European guide in the framework of the CAENTI.

The WP4I coordination group, which is animated by the University of LIEGE in Belgium, makes an inventory of the territorial information that are available on the European and national Internet websites. It will be possible to find all the useful precisions on the territorial indicators in the report called “State-of-the-art of territorial information available on internet and sources in Europe” (deliverable n° 24), as well as in the article “Territorial information, themes, indicators and sources” [CHEN, DEVILLET, 2006].

The WP6C group made a first presentation of the European guide in the DURBUY seminar (Belgium), in June to start the debate on the contents, whilst the WP4I group animators were present. Then, the European guide evolved according to the repertory, and afterwards to the technical constraints of the gathering and of the quantitative examination. Thus, a stabilised version was validated in the International Conference of Territorial Intelligence in ALBA IUIILA (Romania) in September. Then, in this guide the WP6C group made a selection of 44 questions that it would be interesting to compare with territorial information. The WP4I group made a first exploratory analysis, which was coordinated by Di CHEN, among the territorial indicators of which he had made an inventory, to determine those that could be compared with these questions, whilst possibly taking into account the national contexts. It suggests 15 indicators that allow illustrating 20 questions. It indicated the precision level of each indicator, for each country that is a member of the European Union.

This report is a technical document that successively presents:

1. The list of the diagnosis and evaluation guide questions that it is advisable to compare with contextual territorial indicators that are established by the WP6C coordination group. Here, the guide is presented again to indicate the complete formulation of the selected questions.

2. The list of the questions for which the WP4I group could determine a territorial indicator within its inventory of territorial information. Fifteen indicators about twenty questions are presented. The treatment and comparison protocols of these questions and of these indicators should now be defined and instrumented.

3. The list of the guide questions for the ones these indicators have not been found. The exploratory analysis will continue by studying other sources and other comparison modes.

4. Lastly, a table with three parts indicates the degree of territorial precision (NUTS) at which the territorial indicators are accessible.

CONCLUSION

The transversal cooperation between the WP6C and WP4I coordination groups allowed, on the base of a selection of 44 questions of the diagnosis and evaluation guide, selecting 15 territorial indicators that could illustrate 20 questions, what was our initial objective for this CAENTI first period of activity.

Moreover, the WP4I group established the local accessibility of these indicators for each of the States that are members of the European Union, plus Taiwan (participant to the CAENTI). This table shows these indicators are not always available at the local level.

The thinking should now be directed towards the treatment and comparison protocols of the territorial indicators as in many situations, for many indicators, the actors will have to make specific estimations, rather than respecting the advised protocol.

The analysis of the confrontation possibilities of the questions for which we did not directly find the corresponding territorial indicator will continue from local sources. There are activity sectors for which no indicator is suggested although several questions were selected by the actors. The indicators that have interest for the actions that are led by the actors will be more deeply exploited, even if we suggest several procedures according to the States or regions.

We should also record these research activities contribute to the design of a European portal of territorial indicators accessible to the sustainable development actors, which is planned in 2008.

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
